Terms & Conditions

Code of Conduct: All PZ Math Calculus Prep Camp participants are expected to be respectful of and courteous to all fellow participants, instructors, and others present at Symphony Workplaces. Participants should arrive on time and be prepared for camp. Cell phones and other electronic devices should remain on silent throughout class time.

Participants may be dismissed, without a refund, from a Program for conduct deemed by PZ Math to be detrimental to the quality, integrity, or general atmosphere of the program. Such conduct shall include, without limitation, the following: drug/alcohol/tobacco possession or use; viewing pornography or any inappropriate material on the Internet; inappropriate language (swearing, racial slurs, etc.); physical violence or threats of physical violence against other participants or PZ Math instructors; damage to facilities at the Program location or PZ Math equipment; stealing property of others; inappropriate use of equipment; sexual harassment of other participants or PZ Math staff; internet hacking; or bullying.

Lunch: Participants get a 45-minute lunch break each day. There is a cafeteria on the premises where students can purchase food. PZ Math is not responsible for participants during this break, and everyone is expected to return from lunch on time.

Attendance Policy: Attendance is crucial to success at camp. If students must miss some portion of the camp, no partial or full refunds will be given. Participants are welcome back after their absence, though we cannot take time away from the program to tutor participants on missed material.

Media Release: As a condition of participation, I authorize that photos, videos, images, audio and testimonials may be taken of my student and agree that said content may be used by PZ Math in promotional materials, marketing collateral, and online media. These images, testimonials, photos, videos, and audio may be shared and used by corporate partners, the media, or other organizations who work with PZ Math. I understand that PZ Math, its owners, agents, partners, facility providers, and employees will not be held liable for damages and injuries associated with said publishing, including any and all claims based on negligence. I agree that all images, testimonials, photos, video, and audio taken at or in connection with PZ Math are the sole and

exclusive property of PZ Math. Please note that if PZ Math is contacted by the press, we will seek written parent approval before a minor Participant's full name may be used in print, radio, TV and other mediums.

Course Cancellation: I understand that PZ Math reserves the right to cancel a course, in which case a refund will be issued for all monies paid to PZ Math for the cancelled course. I understand and agree that no refunds will be given if PZ Math is forced to cancel a course due to power failure, weather, acts of nature, or other unforeseeable events not within the control of PZ Math.

Returned Check Fee: A \$35 returned check fee will be assessed for any returned checks.

Withdrawals: There will be a \$250 withdrawal fee if a participant cancels his registration before July 3, 2017. No refunds will be given past this date.

PZ Math reserves the right to make changes to assistant instructors or staff or hire additional assistant instructors and teaching assistants in order to maintain a small student/teacher ratio. We reserve the right to cancel a course if participation numbers are not adequate, in which case a full refund will be issued.
